





*Percentage of on-time payments by month.





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

PRI operates in conjunction with various national energy suppliers who have agreed to cooperate and supply natural gas and electricity as specified by PRI. Specifically, Dr. Shkop has been procuring electricity for customers since 2006.

Vice President of Business Development, Hal Pollack, is a Certified Public Accountant and holds a Master of Management Degree from Northwestern University's Kellogg Graduate School of Management. Mr. Pollack worked eight years in public accounting and moved from auditing futures brokerage firms to trading financial futures at the Chicago Mercantile Exchange and the Chicago Board of Trade for nine years. Upon leaving the trading floor, Mr. Pollack has been advising customers on how to control telecommunication, natural gas and electricity costs for almost 15 years as president of Corporate Long Distance Specialists, Inc (an Illinois corporation).
