COMPLAINT

For his complaint against Nationwide Energy Partners LLC, Complainant Mark A. Whitt, in accordance with R.C. 4905.26, R.C. 4928.16 and Rule 4901-9-01(B), O.A.C., alleges and avers as follows:

PARTIES AND JURISDICITION

- Complainant Mark A. Whitt owns a residential condominium in The
 Condominiums at North Bank Park, 300 W. Spring Street, Columbus, Ohio 43215 (North Bank).
 North Bank is located in the Arena District of downtown Columbus.
- 2. Nationwide Energy Partners LLC (NEP) is a foreign limited liability company organized under the laws of Delaware. As alleged herein, NEP supplies or arranges for the supply of electric, water, and sewer service to North Bank. As such, NEP is an "electric light company" under RC 4905.03(C), a "water-works company" under RC 4905.03(G), a "sewage disposal company" under RC 4905.03(M), and a "public utility" under R.C. 4905.02.
- 3. NEP also provides "retail electric service" as defined in RC 4928.01(A)(27), and as such is an "electric distribution utility," "electric light company," "electric services company,"

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"electric utility," and/or "electric supplier" under R.C. 4928.01(A).

4. The Public Utilities Commission of Ohio (Commission) has personal jurisdiction of the parties and subjection matter jurisdiction of this action by virtue of, among other statutes, R.C. 4905.04, R.C. 4905.05, R.C. 4905.06, 4905.26, R.C. 4928.06, R.C. 4928.08, R.C. 4928.09 and R.C. 4928.16.

FACTS COMMON TO ALL CLAIMS

- 5. Complainant incorporates by reference the allegations of paragraphs 1 through 4 of this Complaint.
- 6. Complainant purchased Unit 507 at North Bank in November 2014. At closing, Complainant was informed that NEP is the exclusive provider of utility service to North Bank. In order to receive electric, water, and sewer service, Complainant was required to execute a service agreement with NEP. Complainant has been a customer of NEP from November 2014 to the present.
- 7. On information and belief, NEP provides electric, water, and sewer service to all units within North Bank, as well as common areas of the building.
- 8. Complainant, the sole occupant of Unit 507, uses electricity for heating, refrigeration, cooking and other household uses; water for drinking and bathing; and sewage disposal services for sanitation.
- 9. NEP issues bills to Complainant on a monthly basis. Each bill contains charges for electric, water, and sewer service. Copies of the first bill and most recent bill received by Complainant, with due dates of December 15, 2014 and April 3, 2015, respectively, are attached as Exhibit A (with the account number partially redacted).
- 10. As shown in Exhibit A, the electric charges billed by NEP separately list the generation, transmission, and distribution components of retail electric service. NEP also assesses a customer charge.
 - 11. With respect to electric generation service and in reference to Exhibit A, dividing

the monthly kWh usage by the amount of the generation charge yields generation rates of \$0.1145 and \$0.1270, respectively, for the applicable billing periods. These generation rates are nearly *double* the rates available to shopping customers in AEP Ohio's service territory, and are illustrative of the rates charged to Complainant since moving into North Bank.

- 12. As also shown in Exhibit A, charges billed by NEP separately list water, sewer, and stormwater charges. NEP also assesses a common area water charge and a charge for a "clean river fund."
- 13. None of the rates charged by NEP for any of the services it provides are disclosed in the monthly bills rendered to Complainant. Nor does NEP publish rate information on its website (nationwideenergypartners.com) or by other means.
- 14. None of the rates charged by NEP for any of the services it provides have been reviewed or approved by the Commission as required by, among other statutes, R.C. 4905.22, R.C. 4905.30, 4905.32, and R.C. 4909.18.
- 15. NEP does not possess a certificate of public convenience and necessity to provide water service, as required by R.C. 4933.25.
- 16. NEP does not possess a certificate of public convenience and necessity to provide sewer service, as required by R.C. 4933.25.
- 17. NEP does not have a certified territory authorizing or requiring it to provide electric service, as required by R.C. 4933.83(A).
- 18. NEP is not certified as a supplier of competitive retail electric service, as required by R.C. 4928.08(B).
- 19. NEP is not otherwise listed on the rolls of the Commission as a public utility; has not applied to the Commission for an exemption from regulation as a public utility; and does not

otherwise comply with any applicable provision of Title 49, Ohio Revised Code.

- 20. On information and belief, the service and billing arrangement between NEP and Complainant, described herein, also applies to all other residents of North Bank.
- 21. On information and belief, the rates and charges billed by NEP exceed the rates and charges of utility service providers and suppliers of competitive retail electric service that would serve North Bank, but for NEP's unlawful provision of such services.
- 22. NEP provides and bills for the services described herein "knowingly," as defined in R.C. 4928.01(A)(14).

COUNT I: UNLAWFUL PROVISION OF NONCOMPETITIVE RETAIL ELECTRIC SERVICE

- 23. Complainant incorporates by reference the allegations of paragraphs 1 through 22 of this Complaint.
- 24. NEP bills include a line item for "distribution service" and "transmission service." NEP also supplies or arranges for the supply of metering service, billing and collection service, and ancillary services. Each of the foregoing are "noncompetitive" components of retail electric service under R.C. 4928.01(A)(21) and (B).
- 25. By "supplying or arranging for the supply of electricity to ultimate consumers in this state, from the point of generation to the point of consumption," NEP provides "retail electric service" as defined in 4928.01(A)(27), and is engaged in the business of an "electric light company" as defined in R.C. 4905.03(C), and an "electric distribution utility" and "electric utility" under R.C. 4928.01(A)(6) and (11). As such, NEP is a "public utility" as defined in R.C. 4905.02(A).
- 26. With respect to the services of a public utility, R.C. 4905.22 requires, in relevant part: "All charges made or demanded for any service rendered, or to be rendered, shall be just,

reasonable, and not more than the charges allowed by law or by order of the public utilities commission, and no unjust or unreasonable charge shall be made or demanded for, or in connection with, any service, or in excess of that allowed by law or by order of the commission."

- 27. Under R.C. 4909.18, "Any public utility desiring to establish any rate, joint rate, toll, classification, charge, or rental, or to modify, amend, change, increase, or reduce any existing rate, joint rate, toll, classification, charge, or rental, or any regulation or practice affecting the same, shall file a written application with the public utilities commission."
- 28. The rates charged for noncompetitive retail electric service provided by NEP have not been submitted to, or approved by, the Commission, as required by R.C. 4909.18.
- 29. By supplying or arranging for the supply of noncompetitive components of retail electric service at unapproved and unregulated rates, NEP is engaged in a knowing, continuing violation of R.C. 4905.22 and R.C. 4909.18.

COUNT II: UNLAWFUL PROVISION OF COMPETITIVE RETAIL ELECTRIC SERVICE

- 30. Complainant incorporates by reference the allegations of paragraphs 1 through 29 of this Complaint.
- 31. NEP bills include a line item for "generation service." Generation service is a competitive component of retail electric service under R.C. 4928.03.
- 32. R.C. 4928.08(B) prohibits the provision of a competitive component of retail electric service without first obtaining certification from the Commission to provide such service.
- 33. NEP has neither applied for, nor has the Commission approved, an application or certification for NEP to supply a competitive component of retail electric service.
 - 34. By supplying or arranging for the supply of a competitive retail electric service

without the required certification, NEP is engaged in a knowing, continuing violation of R.C. 4928.08(B).

COUNT III: VIOLATION OF CERTIFIED TERRITORY ACT

- 35. Complainant incorporates by reference the allegations of paragraphs 1 through 34 of this Complaint.
- 36. AEP Ohio (AEP) is an "electric supplier" as defined in R.C. 4933.81(A). AEP has the exclusive right and obligation to furnish "electric service" to all "electric load centers" within its "certified territory," pursuant to R.C. 4933.81 *et seq*.
- 37. North Bank is an electric load center located within the geographic boundaries of AEP's certified territory.
- 38. By supplying or arranging for the supply of retail electric service to North Bank, NEP is an "electric supplier" as defined in R.C. 4933.81(F).
- 39. As an "electric supplier" providing "electric service" to an "electric load center" within the "certified territory" of AEP, NEP is engaged in a knowing, continuing violation of R.C. 4933.83(A).

COUNT IV: UNLAWFUL PROVISION OF WATER SERVICE

- 40. Complainant incorporates by reference the allegations of paragraphs 1 through 39 of this Complaint.
- 41. NEP bills include a line item for water service. NEP is therefore "engaged in the business of supplying water through pipes or tubing, or in a similar manner, to consumers within this state," and is a "water-works company" as defined in R.C. 4905.03(G) and a public utility under R.C. 4905.02(A).
- 42. R.C. 4933.25 prohibits a water works company from operating water distribution facilities until it has been issued a certificate of public convenience and necessity (CPCN) by the Commission.

- 43. By supplying or arranging for the supply of water service without a CPCN, NEP is engaged in a knowing, continuing violation of R.C. 4933.25.
- 44. By supplying or arranging for the supply of water service at unapproved and unregulated rates, NEP is engaged in a knowing, continuing violation of R.C. 4905.22 and R.C. 4909.18.

COUNT V: UNLAWFUL PROVISION OF SEWAGE DISPOSAL SERVICE

- 45. Complainant incorporates by reference the allegations of paragraphs 1 through 44 of this Complaint.
- 46. NEP bills include line items for storm sewer and sanitary sewer services. NEP is therefore "engaged in the business of sewage disposal services through pipes or tubing, and treatment works, or in a similar manner," and is a "sewage disposal company" as defined in R.C. 4905.03(M) and a public utility under R.C. 4905.02.
- 47. R.C. 4933.25 prohibits a sewage disposal company from providing sewage disposal services unless it has been issued a CPCN by the Commission.
- 48. By supplying or arranging for the supply of sewage disposal service without a CPCN, NEP is engaged in a knowing, continuing violation of R.C. 4933.25.
- 49. By supplying or arranging for the supply of sewage disposal service at unapproved and unregulated rates, NEP is engaged in a knowing, continuing violation of R.C. 4905.22 and 4909.18.

PRAYER FOR RELIEF

Complainant respectfully requests that the Commission issue an Order finding and directing that:

- a. The Complaint states reasonable grounds and should be scheduled for hearing, as required by R.C. 4905.26 and R.C. 4909.18;
- b. NEP is knowingly engaged in the business of a public utility, and conducting such business in a manner contrary to law;
- c. NEP is knowingly engaged in the business of supplying a competitive retail electric service, and conducting such business in a manner contrary to law;
- d. The rates, charges, and other sums exacted by NEP are unjust, unreasonable, unfair, discriminatory, and in violation of law;
- e. The services rendered by NEP are unjust, unreasonable, unfair, discriminatory, and in violation of law;
- f. The books and records of NEP should be examined and audited to determine the profits derived from its unlawful provision of service;
- g. Complainant is entitled to refunds for the difference between the rates charged by NEP and a lawful rate, as determined by the Commission; and subject to trebling under R.C. 4905.61;
- h. NEP is subject to penalties and forfeitures, in amounts determined and assessed in accordance with Title 49, Ohio Revised Code;
- i. Complainant is entitled to an award of damages, as authorized by R.C.
 4928.16(B), and subject to trebling under R.C. 4905.61;

- j. The Attorney General is authorized and directed to commence such civil actions as are necessary to effectuate the relief requested herein, including, without limitation, an action directing NEP to show cause why it should not be permanently enjoined from the further provision of services subject to Commission supervision and regulation; and
 - k. Such other and further relief as authorized by law.
