Introduction

Choice Energy, LLC d/b/a 4 Choice Energy, LLC (the "Company") is a CRES that began serving load in the State of Ohio in 2014. As such, this report represents the Company's first Alternative Energy Portfolio Status Report. Throughout 2014 the Company operated within only the Duke Energy Ohio footprint.

Baseline

Since the Company had no sales in each of the previous three years of 2011, 2012 and 2013, actual sales for the entire calendar year 2014 is used as the baseline unadjusted. The total sales (retail load served) in 2014 as reported to the Company by the EDU was 15,266,151 kilowatt-hours.



Compliance

The Company has no generation facility. All of its 2014 renewable energy obligations were met with the purchases of qualified Renewable Energy Certificates (RECs), all of which were tracked and settled with the PJM GATS (see attached "My RPS Compliance" report). As such, there is no alternative compliance payment due.

2. Supply Portfolio Projection

The Company began serving load to its first customer in March 2014 steadily ramping up throughout the rest of 2014 achieving a total 2014 sales of 15,266 MWH. At this time the Company expects to maintain its current customer portfolio base and mix for the foreseeable future with a projected annual sales averaging 29,448 MWH.

3. Description of the Methodology Used to Evaluate Compliance Options

The Company has no generation facility, and at this time expects to meet all its future renewable energy obligations via purchases of qualified Renewable Energy Certificates (RECs).

4. Discussion of Any Perceived Impediments to Achieving Compliance

At this time the Company does not perceive any impediments to achieving compliance in each of the current and future years.
