



I am writing in solidarity with the Ohio Citizen Action Campaign with regard to the rate increase linked to the bailout of First Energy's old, rundown coal plants, which quite frankly belong to a vision of capitalist energy production more appropriate to the nineteenth century than the twenty-first. As an educator who teaches writing and general education to young, future leaders of America, I can say with confidence that the vision of dirty energy production being supported by laws like these are not going to be supported by millions of young people. I ask that you please deny the rate increase to lock consumers into buying power from Ohio's oldest, dirtiest coal plants. My family, my students, and my community care about reducing our toxic pollution and saving money on our electric bills at the same time. A bailout of old, polluting technology only benefits utility shareholders and delays inevitable investment in renewable energy.

While I perfectly understand that you are unlikely to swim against the overwhelming tide of prevailing attitudes among investors at First Energy, which has shown that it intends to give complete and total obedience to the fossil fuel industry in exchange for dollars, I ask that you also consider the alternative. Since 1950, the ppm of CO₂ in the atmosphere has risen at a steady rate of nearly 1 ppm per year. Even if we were to stay at this rate, which is unlikely given that rates of pollution are actually increasing, catastrophic effects from climate change are likely to hit sometime in the next three hundred years. Passing the buck to future generations and forcing them to suffer simply because of our own greed is both unethical and morally reprehensible. I would appeal to your ethical sensibilities.
