

**COMPETITIVE RETAIL ELECTRIC SERVICE PROVIDER ALTERNATIVE ENERGY RESOURCES REPORT FOR  
CALENDAR YEAR 2014**

ResCom Energy, LLC, (hereinafter "ResCom"), in accordance with Sections 4928.64 and 4928.65, Revised Code and Commission Rules 4901:11-40-03 and 4901:1-40-05, hereby submits this Annual Alternative Energy Report ("AER") detailing compliance with Ohio Alternative Energy Portfolio Standards ("OH AEPS").

- I. Determination that an Alternative Energy Resource Report is Required
  - a. During Calendar year 2014, ResCom states that it conducted retail sales of generation to customers who utilized the generation in a load center located within the state of Ohio.
- II. Determination of the sales baseline for 2014
  - a. during the past four calendar years, ResCom made retail sales of generation in the amounts shows below:
    - i. 2011- 0 MWh
    - ii. 2012- 0 MWh
    - iii. 2013- 0 MWh
    - iv. 2014- 1,073 MWh
- III. Determination of the number of solar and total Renewable Energy Credits (RECs) required and statement of the number of RECs Claimed.

- a. Column (a) above lists the unadjusted number of Solar and Total RECs Required for ResCom in 2014. ResCom states that it has obtained the number of Solar and Non Solar RECs listed in column (b) above for 2014.
  - b. ResCom used the PJM GATS registry for the RECs detailed above. Please note that the GATS account holder is ResCom Energy, LLC.
- IV. Compliance
  - a. ResCom states that it has obtained the required number of Solar RECs and Total RECs without adjustments permitted pursuant to Rule 4901:1-40-05(A)(3).

V. Ten Year Forecast

- a. In accordance with Rule 4901:1-40-03(0) DEG hereby provides a projection for the next 10 years for RECs and Solar RECs.

- b. Supply portfolio projection

ResCom does not own any generation assets that can be utilized for Ohio compliance. ResCom intends to purchase both Solar and Non-Solar RECs from generators who have been certified as renewable from PUCO, have joined an approved REC registry and will transfer RECs from the generator's account to the ResCom account.

- c. Methodology used to evaluate compliance

ResCom has used internal forecasting methods to forecast our retail sales over the next ten years, and multiplied the annual sales by the then-current Ohio Alternative Energy Portfolio Standards percentage.

- d. Comments on any perceived impediment(s) to achieving compliance with the Solar and Non-Solar REC requirements, as well as any discussion addressing such impediments.

ResCom does not have any comments at this time.
