Jay Plastics CHP System
Production Report

Jay Plastics' CHP System was entered into service, effective February 1, 2015. System output monitoring was enacted, effective February 13, 2015, following the PUCO Ruling on February 10, 2015. The current method employed to collect data is via gage readings on the Woodward EZGEN panel in the generator control room. This is compared against PLC program monitoring for consistency. Data collected for the period of March 9 until April 6, 2015, indicate that 741,216 kWh were produced by the CHP System. The gage will continue to monitor actual kWh production by the CHP System and will be available for evaluation, measurement and verification by the Utility and by PUCO or their designates.

Jay Plastics' CHP System will operate 24 hours per day, 7 days per week for 26 weeks per year. Factoring 10% downtime for scheduled and unscheduled maintenance, we calculate the annual energy production as 4,336,114 kWh per year. From the formula in the PUCO Finding and Order, using the 4,336,114 kWh energy production, and the recommended incentive rate of \$0.005 per kWh, we calculate an annual payment of \$21,680.57.
