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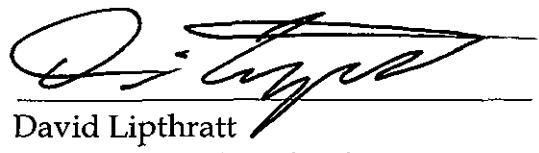

Supplemental Staff Review and Recommendation's Letter

Background

On May 19, 2015, Duke Energy Ohio (DEO) filed proposed tariffs pursuant to the Opinion and Order approved by the Commission on April 2, 2015, in Case Nos. 14-841-EL-SSO and 14-842-EL-ATA. The compliance filing includes proposed retail generation rates that reflect the results of the May 14, 2015, Standard Service Offer (SSO) Auction.

On May 28, 2015, DEO filed a revised version of Rider RC, Sheet No. 111.5, to correct an error contained in the original compliance filing for Rate SFL-ADPL.

Staff Review and Recommendations

Staff has reviewed the correction filed on May 28, 2015, and finds that the corrected Rider RC, Sheet No. 111.5, appears to be in compliance with the Commission's Opinion and Order.

Conclusion

The Staff recommends that the Compliance Filing filed on May 19, 2015, and revised on May 28, 2015 be approved and become effective on a service rendered basis beginning June 1, 2015.
