

ALTERNATIVE ENERGY RESOURCE REPORT FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2014**

Western Reserve Energy Services, LLC ("WRES") in accordance with Section 4928.64 and 4928.65 ORC and Commission Rules 4901:1-40-03 and 4901:1-40-05 hereby submits this Alternative Energy Report ("AER") detailing compliance with the Ohio Alternative Energy Portfolio Standards.

- I. Determination that an Alternative Energy Resource Report is required.

During calendar year 2014 WRES states that it conducted retail sales of generation to customer who utilized the generation in a load center located within the State of Ohio.

- II. Determination of the sales baseline for 2014.

WRES' actual metered load served in 2014 was 47,508 MWhs.

- III. Determination of the number of Solar and Total Renewable Energy Credits (RECs) required and statement of the number of RECs claimed.

Column (a) represents 0.012% of sales for Solar RECs and 2.5% of sales for Total RECs.

- IV. Compliance

WRES states that it has obtained the required number of Solar and Total RECs (listed in column B above) without adjustments permitted pursuant to Rule 4901:1-40-03(B)(2)(9)

- V. Ten Year Forecast

- a. WRES began servicing customers in 2012. As a CRES provider with no generation, WRES typically only provides customer contracts between 12 and 36 months. Accordingly, we have provided a forecast for the next 5 years.

b. Supply portfolio projection

WRES does not own any generation assets that can be utilized for Ohio compliance and does not carry forward RECs except for obligations related to its already contracted customers. WRES purchases RECs on an as needed basis.

c. Methodology used to evaluate compliance.

WRES will continue to meet its alternative energy benchmarks through the purchasing of RECs via brokers and directly with REC suppliers.

d. Impediments to achieving compliance.

As long as sufficient RECs are available in the market, there should be no issues acquiring them.

VI. Conclusion

Based on the foregoing, WRES respectfully requests that the Commission find that WRES has complied with the applicable renewable energy benchmarks for 2014.
