You have already received a letter from Troy Township and Constellation regarding your opt-out Electric Aggregation Program. Your last letter referenced a 17-digit Service Delivery Number from your Ohio Edison bill. This form should have referenced a 20-digit customer number found on your Ohio Edison bill. Constellation wanted to inform you that you may opt-out of this program at any time without penalty by calling 1-866-977-7630. You do not need your customer number or Opt-Out code to opt-out. We apologize for any confusion the opt-out slip may have created.

If you have already opted out of Troy Township's Aggregation Program, no further action is required.

If you do not opt out of the program by June 9, you will be automatically enrolled. Your new fixed rate of 7.57 cents per kWh for 24 months will begin with your first billing cycle in August 2015. There is no cost for the enrollment and you will not be charged a switching fee. Constellation's price applies to the generation and transmission portion of your bill. Constellation's price does not include applicable taxes, or utility fees and charges. You will continue to receive a single bill from Ohio Edison for your electric service with your Constellation NewEnergy rate included. If you are ever unhappy with your service or rate from Constellation, you may cancel free of charge at any time and return to Ohio Edison at a rate and terms that may or may not be the same as what other Ohio Edison customers pay.

After you become a participant in the Troy Township's Electric Aggregation Program, Ohio Edison will send a letter confirming your selection of Constellation as your retail electric service provider. As required by law, this letter will inform you of your option to cancel your enrollment with Constellation within seven business days of the postmark date of the letter.
