MOTION FOR EXTENSION

Pursuant to Rule 4901:1-24-09(B) of the Ohio Administrative Code, Progressive Energy Consultants, LLC ("PEC") of 1080 Kapp Dr., Clearwater, FL 33765, seeks an extension of Certificate No. 13-708E(1) which was issued in Case No. 13-1331-EL-AGG. The expiration date of Certificate No. 13-708E(1) is July 6, 2015. Due to the press of other business, PEC was not able to file its renewal application on time. It has now filed its renewal application on June 16, 2015 which is twenty calendar days prior to the July 6, 2015 expiration date. 
**MEMORANDUM IN SUPPORT OF
