## The Commission finds:

- (1) Generally, pursuant to R.C. 4905.26, the Commission has authority to consider written complaints filed against a public utility by any person or corporation regarding any rate, service, regulation, or practice relating to any service furnished by the public utility that is in any respect unjust, unreasonable, insufficient, or unjustly discriminatory.
- (2) On May 19, 2014, this complaint was filed by Tony Lyons on behalf of Levon LLC (Complainant or Levon), as a member of Levon, against The East Ohio Gas Company LLC dba Dominion East Ohio (DEO). The complaint contends that, when one of the Complainant's tenants violated the lease and moved away without notice, DEO transferred the gas service into Complainant's name without prior authorization.
- (3) DEO filed its answer on June 9, 2014. DEO asserts that it attempted to disconnect service at Complainant's property but could not gain access, and subsequently DEO claims to have sent Complainant a letter requesting access indicating that service would be changed to Complainant's name if access was not made available in ten days. DEO alleges the Company refused access to the property, and thus, DEO established service in Complainant's name.

- (4) By Entry issued July 15, 2014, a settlement conference was scheduled for August 18, 2014. The parties met, but did not resolve the matter.
- (5) By Entry issued January 27, 2015, a hearing was scheduled for March 19, 2015. On March 10, 2015, Complainant filed a request for continuance of the hearing. The continuance was granted in a March 13, 2015 Entry.
- (6) On April 15, 2015, Mr. Lyons filed a letter on behalf of the Complainant indicating that the Complainant would not be pursuing this matter any further.
- (7) Accordingly, the Commission finds that this matter should be dismissed and closed of record at the request of the Complainant.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That this complaint be dismissed and closed of record. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon all parties of record.
