The Public Utilities Commission of Ohio calls
for hearing at this time and place Case No.
14-563-EL-RDR being in the Matter of The Dayton
Power and Light Company to Modify its
Competitive Bid True-up Rider.

Attorney Examiner assigned by the Commission to

Griffin on behalf of Dayton Power and Light

14 2014. It's 12 pages including the cover letter.

20 Stipulation and Recommendation comprised of 5
21 pages, and that was filed a May 28th.

20 A. I recommend the Commission approve
21 the Stipulation and Recommendation in its
22 entirety without modification.

24 Honor, with that I have no further questions.

1 Griffin. Mr. Beeler, any cross-examination?
