ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) A settlement conference was held in this complaint case on August 25, 2015.
- (2) On August 25, 2015, Staff filed a letter in this matter. In the letter, Staff states that a collateral proceeding, which is related to this case, is currently pending before the Elyria Municipal Court for Lorain County, Ohio. Staff states that the municipal court proceeding shares common issues of fact with this case and that, depending on the outcome of that proceeding, an evidentiary hearing in this case may not be necessary. Staff requests that the scheduling of an evidentiary hearing in this case be held in abeyance pending resolution of the collateral proceeding. Further, Staff states that it is currently monitoring the Elyria Municipal Court's docket and will provide notice via letter once there is a resolution of that proceeding.
- (3) The attorney examiner finds that the scheduling of an evidentiary hearing in this case shall be held in abeyance pending resolution of the above-mentioned Elyria Municipal Court proceeding and notification by Staff that a hearing is necessary.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That Staff's request to hold the scheduling of an evidentiary hearing in this case in abeyance be granted in accordance with Finding (3). It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon each party of record.
