ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) Ohio Edison Company, The Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company, and The Toledo Edison Company (collectively, FirstEnergy) are electric distribution utilities as defined in R.C. 4928.01(A)(6) and public utilities as defined in R.C. 4905.02 and, as such, are subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission.
- (2) R.C. 4928.141 provides that an electric distribution utility shall provide customers within its certified territory a standard service offer (SSO) of all competitive retail electric services necessary to maintain essential electric services to customers, including firm supply of electric generation services. The SSO may be either a market rate offer in accordance with R.C. 4928.142 or an electric security plan (ESP) in accordance with R.C. 4928.143.
- (3) On August 4, 2014, FirstEnergy filed an application pursuant to R.C. 4928.141 to provide for an SSO to provide generation pricing for the period of June 1, 2016, through May 31, 2019. The application is for an ESP, in accordance with R.C. 4928.143.
- (4) The case proceeded to hearing on August 31, 2015, and is currently ongoing. A large portion of the hearing thus far has been conducted in a closed, confidential session due to the discussion of information claimed to be confidential trade secret information, and further closed, confidential sessions are expected during the remainder of the hearing. A number of intervening parties in the case signed protective agreements with FirstEnergy in order to access the confidential information and competitively sensitive confidential information.

- (5) The attorney examiner finds that the following persons from the following intervening parties, Ohio Power Co. (AEP Ohio), Hardin Wind, LLC (Hardin Wind), Nucor Steel Marion (Nucor), Ohio Consumers' Counsel (OCC), Ohio Energy Group (OEG), Exelon Generation Company, LLC (Exelon), Ohio Manufacturers' Association Energy Group (OMAEG), Northeast Ohio Public Energy Council (NOPEC), Industrial Energy Users-Ohio (IEU-Ohio), Monitoring Analytics, LLC (Marketing Analytics), Mid-Atlantic Renewable Energy Coalition (MAREC), the Electric Power Supply Association (EPSA), the Sierra Club, Ohio Environmental Council (OEC), Environmental Defense Fund (EDF), Retail Energy Supply Association (RESA), the Kroger Company (Kroger), Wal-Mart Stores East, LP (Wal-Mart), the Northwest Ohio Aggregation Coalition (NOAC), PJM Power Providers Group (P3), Ohio Hospital Association (OHA), Direct Energy Services, LLC (Direct Energy), Interstate Gas Supply, Inc.
