FINDING AND ORDER

The Commission finds:

- (1) The Dayton Power and Light Company (DP&L) is an electric distribution utility as defined in R.C. 4928.01(A)(6), and a public utility as defined in R.C. 4928.02, and, as such, is subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission.
- (2) Pursuant to R.C. 4928.11(A) and 4928.06, the Commission is required to adopt rules that establish uniform interconnection standards to ensure transmission and distribution system safety and reliability and that provide for high quality, safe, and reliable electric service.
- (3) On May 19, 2014, the Commission final filed with the Joint Committee on Agency Rule Review (JCARR) amended rules in Ohio Adm.Code Chapter 4901:1-22, with an effective date of July 10, 2014, requiring electric utilities to file revised or updated interconnection tariffs.
- (4) On July 10, 2014, DP&L filed an application for approval of its revised interconnection tariff containing the terms and conditions regarding interconnection to comply with the amended rules in Ohio Adm.Code Chapter 4901:1-22.
- (5) Thereafter, on October 28, 2014, DP&L filed an amended application for approval of its proposed interconnection tariff. The tariff sheets were revised so that the language would more closely reflect the language of the amended rules in Ohio Adm.Code Chapter 4901:1-22.
- (6) No party filed comments or objections to DP&L's application for approval of an interconnection tariff.

- (7) On May 15, 2015, Staff filed its Review and Recommendations regarding DP&L's application for approval of a revised interconnection tariff. Staff indicates that DP&L has satisfied the interconnection service tariff filing requirement. However, Staff notes that DP&L's amended interconnection tariff is inconsistent with respect to potential interconnections that may impact the transmission system. Staff notes that the applicability section of DP&L's proposed tariff indicates that the tariff should not apply to interconnections at the transmission level. However, the Level 3 standard review procedure in Ohio Adm.Code Chapter 4901:1-22 considers impacts at the transmission level for certain interconnections. Accordingly, Staff recommends that DP&L revise the applicability language of its amended interconnection tariff to recognize impacts at the transmission level pursuant to Level 3 standard review procedure in Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-22.
- (8) On September 4, 2015, DP&L filed an amended proposed interconnection tariff adopting Staff's recommendation.
- (9) The Commission finds that DP&L's proposed interconnection tariff, as filed on September 4, 2015, does not appear to be unjust or unreasonable and should be approved. Additionally, since no party filed comments or objections to DP&L's application for approval of an interconnection tariff, we find that no hearing is necessary in this matter.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That DP&L's application to amend its interconnection tariff, as filed on September 4, 2015, be approved. It is, further,

ORDERED, That DP&L file, in final form, two complete copies its tariff, consistent with this Finding and Order. One copy shall be filed in this case docket and one copy in its TRF docket. It is, further,

ORDERED, That the effective date of the new tariff shall be a date not earlier than the date of this Finding and Order, and the date upon which the final tariffs are filed with the Commission. It is, further,


ORDERED, That nothing in this Finding and Order shall be binding upon the Commission in any future proceeding or investigation involving the justness or reasonableness of any rate, charge, rule, or regulation. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this Finding and Order be served upon all parties in this proceeding.




