ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) Pursuant to R.C. 4905.26, the Commission has authority to consider written complaints filed against a public utility by any person or corporation regarding any rate, service, regulation, or practice relating to any service furnished by the public utility that is in any respect unjust, unreasonable, insufficient, or unjustly discriminatory.
- (2) Respondent, The Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company (CEI) is a public utility as defined in R.C. 4905.02 and, as such, is subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission.
- (3) On May 3, 2014, Complainant, Darryl Rosenberg, filed a complaint against CEI, alleging that he was overcharged for electric utility service, based on actions CEI took in removing and replacing Complainant's service meter.
- (4) By Entry issued on April 28, 2015, CEI was granted an extension of time to file its answer in this case. On March 27, 2015, CEI timely filed its answer on May 20, 2014, denying the allegations of the complaint and raising several affirmative defenses.
- (5) A prehearing settlement conference, originally scheduled for October 2, 2014, was rescheduled twice, and was held on April 9, 2015. The parties continued working towards a settlement thereafter.


- (6) On August 14, 2015, Complainant and Respondent filed a joint motion to dismiss the complaint with prejudice, stating that the parties have reached a settlement of all issues in this proceeding.
- (7) The Commission finds that the parties' joint motion to dismiss with prejudice is reasonable and should be granted. Accordingly, the complaint should be dismissed.

It is, therefore,


ORDERED, That this complaint be dismissed with prejudice and closed of record. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon all interested parties of record.






