
Dear Sirs,





Dear Commissioners,

I am writing regarding case number 14-1297-EL-SSO, which involves the request by Duke Energy, First Energy and AEP to raise energy rates in order to maintain old, outdated energy plants. Most of these are coal-burning plants. I am opposed to this strongly, on several bases:

- My family and I care about protecting the environment.
- Energy was deregulated in Ohio in 1999, and the energy companies should have the foresight to invest in more efficient energy generation. This action would reward them for lack of foresight. I don't allow this kind of behavior from my children or employees, and do not think it makes good public policy.
- I do not wish to be forced to pay a rate increase to support these plants, regardless of the source of my energy.
- This is a bailout for the sake of these utility companies and their shareholders; they have complete control, and should pay for their decisions and inefficiencies.
