ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) Double T Transportation Co. (Respondent) was served with a Notice of Preliminary Determination (NPD), pursuant to Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-12, on July 12, 205. The NPD assessed no civil forfeiture against Respondent for a violation of traffic laws. On July 24, 2015, Respondent requested an administrative hearing, thereby initiating this case.
- (2) A settlement conference was convened in this matter on August 25, 2015.
- (3) On August 25, 2015, Staff filed a letter requesting that the scheduling of an evidentiary hearing in this matter case be held in abeyance pending resolution of a collateral proceeding in Elyria County Municipal Court that shares common issues of fact with this case. Thereafter, by Entry dated August 31, 2015, the attorney examiner granted Staff's motion pending resolution of the above-mentioned Elyria County Municipal Court proceeding.
- (4) On September 28, 2015, Staff filed a motion to dismiss. In the motion, Staff moves to dismiss this case based upon a satisfactory resolution of the Elyria County Municipal Court proceeding. Staff states that the parties have decided that it is unnecessary to litigate this matter further. Accordingly, Staff requests that the Commission dismiss this case and close the record.
- (5) In view of the satisfactory resolution of the collateral proceeding in Elyria County Municipal Court, this case should be dismissed and closed of record.

It is, therefore,
