NOTICE OF PROPOSED MAJOR UTILITY FACILITY

AEP Ohio Transmission Company (AEP Ohio Transco), an affiliate of AEP Ohio, has filed an amendment to with Ohio Power Siting Board seeking to modify its certificate of environmental compatibility and public need for the Biers Run-Circleville 138-kilovoit (kV) Transmission Line Project. The Ohlo Power Siting Board approved the Biers Run-Circleville 138-kV Transmission Line Project in case number 13-0430-EL-BTX in March 2015.

The purpose of the amendment is to adjust the approved route to accommodate landowner preferences, stay outside road right-of-way, and resolve engineering challenges identified during design.

AEP Ohlo Transco believes the adjustments to the approved route can be reasonably accommodated without causing increased impacts and have, therefore, proposed the adjustments in the amendment. In the agustments in the amendment. In the event the proposed adjustments are not approved by the siting board, AEP Ohio Transco intends to proceed with constructing that portion of the project on the route previously approved by the siting board.

Those who wish to comment or raise objections to the proposed amendment may do so by filing written comments or request for a hearing with the stiling board within 10 days of the publication of this notice. Written comme

The approved Biers Run-Circleville 138-kV transmission line will extend from Biers Run Substation to the Circleville Substation and will be approximately 19 miles long. The line will traverse Deerfield and Union townships in Ross County, and Circleville and Wayne townships in Pickaway County. The proposed amendment would allow AFP Ohio Transco to adjust the transmission line route along the west side of the requesting landowner's property to lessen the line's effects on farming

The accompanying map depicts the proposed line route for the Biers Run-Circleville line. It should be noted that due to the reduced scale and limited detail, this man should be used only as a general guide. 

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

On the application for an amendment of a certificate, the board shall hold a hearing in the same manner as a hearing is held for an application for a certificate if the proposed change in the facility would result in any material increase in any environmental impact of the facility or a substantial change in the location of all or a portion of such facility other than as provided in the alternates set forth in the application.

The chairman of the power siting board shall cause each application field with the board to be investigated and shall, not less than 15 days prior to the date any application is set for hearing, submit a written report to the board and to the applicant. A copy of such report shall be made available to any person upon request. Such report shall set forth the nature of the investigation and shall contain recommended findings with regard to division (A) of Section 4905.10 of the Revised Code and shall become part of the record and served upon all parties to the proceeding.
