The December 16, 2013 Opinion, Order, and Certificate approving Northwest Ohio Wind Energy, LLC's [now known as Trishe Wind Ohio, LLC ("Trishe")] Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need ("Certificate") and the October 1, 2013 Supplement to Amended Application ("Supplement") established a set of conditions and supplemental commitments as part of the Certificate.

Within this set of conditions and commitments, **Certificate Condition No. 10** requires that:

As the information becomes known, the Applicant shall provide Staff the date on which construction will begin, the date on which construction was completed, and the date on which the facility begins commercial operation.

Trishe held a preconstruction conference on November 23, 2015, with the Staff. At the conference, construction-related issues were satisfactorily addressed including all conditions of the Certificate. All preconstruction commitments/conditions have been submitted to Staff as previously docketed.

In compliance with Certificate Condition 10, and as directed by Staff, substation construction activities will commence November 30, 2015. If you have any questions please call at the number listed above.
