MOTION FOR PERMISSION FOR MATTHEW S. MCKENZIE TO APPEAR PRO HAC VICE BEFORE THE COMMISSION

Pursuant to Rule XII of the Supreme Court Rules for the Government of the Bar of Ohio, the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio (the "Commission") is respectfully requested to grant Matthew S. McKenzie (PHV-5903-2015) permission to appear *pro hac vice* and participate as co-counsel in the above-captioned proceeding for American Electric Power affiliated entities through the American Electric Power Service Corporation.
