INTRALATA PRESUBSCRIPTION

1.1 GENERAL

IntraLATA Presubscription is a procedure whereby a subscriber designates to the Telephone Company the carrier which the subscriber wishes to be the carrier of choice for IntraLATA toll calls. Such calls are automatically directed to the designated carrier without the need to use carrier access codes or additional dialing to direct the call to the designated carrier. IntraLATA Presubscription does not prevent a subscriber who has presubscribed to an IntraLATA toll carrier from using carrier access codes or additional dialing to direct calls to an alternative IntraLATA toll carrier on a per call basis.

IntraLATA Presubscription will become effective November 10, 1997.

1.2 INTRALATA PRESUBSCRIPTION OPTIONS

- Option A: Subscriber may select the Telephone Company's IntraLATA carrier as the presubscribed carrier for IntraLATA toll calls subject to Presubscription.
- Option B: Subscriber may select an interrelate toll carrier as the presubscribed carrier for IntraLATA toll calls subject to Presubscription.
- Option C: Subscriber may select a carrier other than the Telephone Company's IntraLATA carrier or the subscriber's InterRELate toll carrier as the presubscribed carrier for IntraLATA toll calls subject to Presubscription.
- Option D: Subscriber may select no presubscribed carrier for IntraLATA toll calls subject to Presubscription which will require the subscriber to dial a carrier access code to route all IntraLATA toll calls to the carrier of choice for each call.

1.3 RULES AND REGULATIONS

Subscribers of record on the effective date of this tariff will retain their current dialing arrangements until they request that their dialing arrangements be changed.

Subscribers of record or new subscribers may select either Options A, B, C, or D for IntraLATA Presubscription.

Subscribers may change their selected Option and/or their presubscribed IntraLATA toll carrier at any time subject to charges specified in Paragraph 1.5 below.

New local service subscribers will be asked to select a carrier(s) for their IntraLATA tdl and InterLATA calls subject to presubscription at the time they place an order with the Telephone Company for local exchange service. If the new subscriber is unable to make a selection at that time, the new subscriber will be read a random listing of all available IntraLATA toll carriers to aid their selection. If the new subscriber is still unable to make a selection at that time, the Telephone Company will inform the new subscriber that he/she will be given ninety (90) days in which to inform the Telephone Company of an IntraLATA toll presubscription carrier choice at no charge. The new subscriber will also be informed that the Telephone Company will assess a charge for any selections made after the ninety (90) day window and that until a selection is made the subscriber will be required to dial a carrier access code to route all IntraLATA toll calls.

New subscribers who do not make an IntraLATA toll carrier presubscription choice at the time the new subscriber places an order establishing local exchange service with the Telephone Company will not be presubscribed to any IntraLATA toll carrier, but rather will be required to dial a carrier access code to route all IntraLATA toll calls to the carrier of choice for each call.

As specified above, a nonrecurring charge will apply for subsequent changes to the end user's selection of a predesignated IC (PIC), including the establishment or removal of a no PIC selection. The nonrecurring charge to process a PIC change request is bifurcated into four (4) separate nonrecurring charges and applies as follows:

- a. A nonrecurring charge, as set forth in 1.5.2, following, applies when the PIC change request is submitted to the Telephone Company through manual methods.
- b. A nonrecurring charge, as set forth in 1.5.2, following, applies when the PIC change request is submitted to the Telephone Company through electronic methods.

Electronic methods shall include all other methods. If a PIC change request utilizing an electronic method results in manual processing, the electronic nonrecurring charge shall apply upon completion of the request. (N)

INTRASTATE CARRIER COMMON LINE ACCESS SERVICE

The Telephone Company will provide Carrier Common Line Access Service (Carrier Common Line Access) to interexchange service providers ("IXCs") in conjunction with Switched Access Service provided in Section 6. of CenturyLink Operating Companies Tariff F.C.C. No. 1.

1. General Description

Carrier Common Line Access provides for the use of end users' Telephone Company-provided common lines by IXCs for access to such end users to furnish intrastate communications.

Premium Access is (1) Switched Access Service provided to customers under this tariff which furnish intrastate MTS/WATS, and (2) Switched Access Service in an end office converted to equal access.

2. Limitations

2.1 Exclusions

Neither a telephone number nor detail billing is provided with Carrier Common Line Access. Additionally, directory listings and intercept arrangements are not included in the rates and charges for Carrier Common Line Access.

2.2 Access Groups

All line side connections provided in the same access group will be limited to the same features and operating characteristics.

All trunk side connections provided in the same access group will be limited to the same features and operating characteristics.
