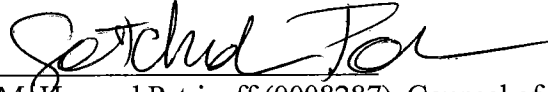

Pursuant to Rule 4901-1-24(D), Ohio Administrative Code, the PJM Power Providers Group ("P3") and the Electric Power Supply Association ("EPSA") jointly file this motion for a protective order seeking confidential treatment of certain testimony included in the unredacted version of their Joint Initial Brief, which is being filed this same day by P3 and EPSA in this case. This joint motion seeks confidential treatment of testimony deemed confidential by Ohio Power Company and given confidential treatment during the evidentiary hearing. The underlying reasons are detailed in the attached memorandum. Consistent with the above-cited rule, two unredacted copies of the testimony are submitted under seal.

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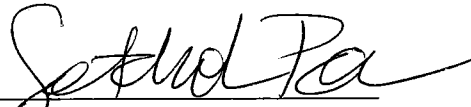

**MEMORANDUM IN SUPPORT
OF JOINT MOTION FOR PROTECTIVE ORDER**

The PJM Power Providers Group (“P3”) and the Electric Power Supply Association (“EPSA”) respectfully request that information included on pages 36 and 48 in the unredacted version of their Joint Initial Brief be protected from public disclosure. The information for which P3/EPSA seeks protection is testimony that Ohio Power Company (“AEP Ohio”) has asserted is confidential and proprietary and would harm AEP Ohio if released to the public. This information is part of the confidential portion of the hearing transcript (Transcript Volume 3). Consistent with the confidential treatment already afforded to this testimony, P3 and EPSA file this joint motion for protective order.

Rule 4901-1-24(D), Ohio Administrative Code, provides that the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio (“Commission”) or certain designated employees may issue an order which is necessary to protect the confidentiality of information contained in documents filed with the Commission’s Docketing Division to the extent that state or federal law prohibits the release of the information and where non-disclosure of the information is not inconsistent with the purposes of Title 49 of the Revised Code. The Attorney Examiners have given confidential treatment of this testimony and consistent with that confidential treatment, P3 and EPSA respectfully request that the Commission grant their joint motion for protective order and maintain the subject portions of their Joint Initial Brief under seal.

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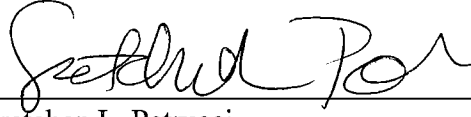
