ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) Pursuant to Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-2, Commission Staff served a notice of preliminary determination upon Charlie Wasaya alleging violations of the Commission's transportation regulations.
- (2) On June 1, 2015, Charlie Wasaya filed a request for an administrative hearing in the above-captioned case in accordance with Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-13.
- (3) A prehearing settlement conference was held on July 16, 2015; however, the parties were unable to settle this matter.
- (4) By Entry issued on July 22, 2015, the attorney examiner scheduled this matter for hearing to take place on October 27, 2015.
- (5) Thereafter, on October 23, 2015, Commission Staff filed a motion to continue this case and a memorandum in support. By Entry issued on October 26, 2015, the attorney examiner granted Staff's motion to continue this case and scheduled this matter for hearing to take place on January 14, 2016.
- (6) Subsequently, on December 23, 2015, Charlie Wasaya filed a motion to continue this case with a memorandum in support. By Entry issued on January 4, 2016, the attorney examiner granted the motion to continue the case and scheduled this matter for hearing to take place on February 23, 2016.
- (7) On February 5, 2016, the parties filed a joint motion to continue the hearing in this case. The joint motion notes that the parties have scheduling conflicts for the scheduled hearing date of February 23, 2016. The joint motion requests that a new hearing date be set during the week of April 4, 2016.

- (8) The attorney examiner finds that the joint motion for continuance filed by the parties is reasonable and should be granted. Accordingly, the hearing in this case is rescheduled for April 5, 2016, at 10:00 a.m., at the offices of the Commission, Hearing Room 11-D, 180 East Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio 43215-3793.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the joint motion to continue the hearing in this case be granted, in accordance with Finding (8). It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon each party of record.
