ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On November 12, 2015, William M. Heyman (Complainant) filed a complaint against Frontier Communications, Inc. (Frontier). The complaint alleges that Frontier failed to mark its telephone lines properly and that Frontier's lines were damaged as a result of the Complainant excavating to replace water lines to his rental property.
- (2) On December 2, 2015, Frontier filed a motion for additional time to answer the complaint.
- (3) After requesting and being granted additional time to answer the complaint, Frontier filed an answer to the complaint on December 28, 2015.¹
- (4) By Entry issued January 15, 2016, the attorney examiner scheduled a prehearing settlement conference to take place on February 23, 2016.
- (5) On February 16, 2016, the Complainant filed a motion for a 60-day continuance to allow time to conduct discovery.
- (6) The attorney examiner finds the motion for continuance is reasonable and should be granted. Accordingly, the February 23, 2016 settlement conference shall be continued and

rescheduled for April 28, 2016, at 1:00 p.m., in Room 1247, at the offices of the Commission, 12th Floor, 180 East Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio 43215.

ORDERED, That the motion for continuance be granted and that the settlement conference scheduled for February 23, 2016, be rescheduled for April 28, 2016, at 1:00 p.m., in Room 1247, at the offices of the Commission, 12th Floor, 180 East Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio 43215. It is, further,
