The Commission finds:


- (1) On September 11, 2015, Hayk Tadevosyn (Respondent) filed a request for an administrative hearing in accordance with Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-13.
- (2) A prehearing conference was conducted on November 17, 2015.
- (3) On January 6, 2016, Staff filed a motion to dismiss, stating that Respondent had paid the civil forfeiture in full.
- (4) Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-22 provides that payment of the forfeiture shall terminate all other proceedings regarding that violation.
- (5) In light of the payment of the forfeiture, Staff's motion should be granted and this case closed.

It is, therefore,


ORDERED, That Staff's motion is granted and this case closed. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon each party of record.


