**SUMMARY**

On November 24, 2015, Vectren Energy Delivery of Ohio, Inc. (Vectren) filed an application seeking to amend the nomination deadlines contained in its transportation tariffs. The amendments are due to a ruling by the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC), in Docket No. RM14-2-000. In its final ruling FERC modified the nomination practices used by interstate pipelines to schedule gas transportation services. FERC's ruling extended the deadline for timely nomination to 1:00 pm central clock time (CCT). In this application Vectren is proposing to amend tariff Sheet No. 51, Original Page 1, Sheet No. 52, Second Revised Page 11 and Sheet No. 56, First Revised Page 5, to reflect FERC's nomination deadline of 1:00 pm CCT.

**STAFF REVIEW**

Staff has reviewed the application filed in the above case and finds it to be reasonable. Vectren's application is consistent with the FERC ruling that revised interstate pipeline nomination schedules and the scheduling of gas to Vectren's system.

**STAFF RECOMMENDATION**

Staff believes that the application filed by Vectren is reasonable and should be approved.
