
AEP Ohio Transmission Company, Inc., (AEP Ohio Transco), an affiliate of AEP Ohio, proposes to expand an existing 138-kilovolt (kV) transmission substation in Olive Township in Noble County

The purpose of the South Caldwell Station Expansion Project is to improve electric service reliability improve electric service reliabili in Noble, Washington and Monroe counties. The project involves expanding the existing South Caldwell Substation by approximately a half-acre. The substation will be expanded on the property owned by AEP Ohio Transco. This project will be an approximate \$10 million investment by AEP Ohio Transco. Construction is scheduled to begin in March 2016.

The project is known as the South Caldwell Station Expansion Project. AEP Ohio Transco filed a Letter of Notification with the Ohio Power Siting Board, under Case No. 16-0033-EL-BLN. This number should be included in all communications with respect to this project. The Letter of Notification to construct, operate and maintain this facility is now pending before

Petitions to intervene in the Letter of Notification will be accepted by the siting board up to 10 days following the publication date of this notice required by Rule 4906-2-12, Ohio Administrative Code. Petitions should be addressed to Ohio Power Siting Board, 180 East Broad Street Columbus, Ohio, 43215-3793 and
