MEMORANDUM IN SUPPORT

TMGES, Inc. ("Company") submitted its original application for certification and was approved by the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio ("PUCO" or "Commission") on February 12, 2012. The renewal application was required to be filed at least thirty (30) days prior to the expiration, or by March 15, 2016. However, due to a mis-calendaring of the expiration date, the application was not filed until March 9, 2016.

Ohio Adm. Code Rule 4901:1-24-09 states:


(A) No less than thirty and no more than sixty calendar days prior to the expiration date indicated on the competitive retail electric service provider's certificate, the provider shall file an application with the commission for certification renewal on forms supplied by the commission.

(B) Any renewal application filed fewer than thirty calendar days prior to the expiration date indicated on the certificate, but no later than the expiration date on the certificate, shall be filed with a motion requesting an extension of the certificate. If the motion is filed in conformance with rule 4901:1-24-07 or 4901:1-24-13 of the Administrative Code, it shall be deemed automatically approved unless, within three business days of its filing, the commission or an attorney examiner appointed by the commission rules otherwise.

The Company respectfully requests that the Commission extend its current certification for an additional thirty (30) days, to allow sufficient time for review and approval of the Company's renewal certification application.

WHEREFORE, for the above-reasons, TMGES, Inc. respectfully requests that the Commission grant its motion to extend, for an additional thirty (30) calendar days, the expiration date of the current certificate.
