It has reached a point where almost 30% of my electric bill is additional costs not associated with that month's electric usage. In winter months, this additional charge has exceeded \$120 by itself!

In addition, DP&L changed their itemized bill to a simpler format this past year "for the customer". All this did was further hide how much of our bill is recovery fees.

A few years ago I attempted to find out exactly what recovery fees I was being charged and how they were calculated. After three months, no one at PUCO or DP&L could find the answer.

PUCO was not created to service the utility companies, but to also protect the consumer. However, in all my dealings with PUCO, the definite impression is PUCO is heavily biased in favor of the utility companies.

I recommend that DP&L be required to cut their stock dividends before the public consumer is forced to cover this charge.
