As a result, I move for a default 4 5 judgment under Ohio Administrative Code Rule 6 4901:2-7-14 Section (E). This section provides that 7 a Respondent who requests an administrative hearing 8 and fails to appear for the hearing shall be in default. A Respondent in default shall be deemed to 9 10 have admitted the occurrence of the violation and 11 waived all further right to contest liability for the 12 forfeiture proposed in the Notice of Preliminary 13 Determination or to contest the making of the 14 compliance order described in the Notice of 15 Preliminary Determination. 16 At this time I would like to mark two 17 exhibits. 18 EXAMINER WALSTRA: Okay. 19 MR. MAYES: I would like to mark as Staff 20 Exhibit 1 the Notice of Preliminary Determination 21 that was issued to Ronald Kasperek. It -- in the 22 notice it explains that Mr. Kasperek was cited for a 23 violation of 49CFR 392.10(A)(4), failure to stop at a 24 railroad crossing which holds a forfeiture amount of 25 \$500. I would like to mark that as Staff Exhibit 1.

MAYES: I would like to mark as Staff 4 Exhibit 2 the Driver/Vehicle Examination Report in 5 this case which states that the Ohio State Highway 6 Patrol deleted Violation 393.10(A)(4) and added 7 Violation 393.10(A)(3). This change clarifies that 8 the truck was not a cargo tank as described in 9 393.10(A)(4) but instead was required to be marked or 10 placarded under the Division 2.2 classification as 11 specified in 393.10(A)(3) and, therefore, was 12 required to stop before crossing at a railroad 13 crossing. 14 EXAMINER WALSTRA: So marked. 15 (EXHIBIT MARKED FOR IDENTIFICATION.) 16 MS. MESSENGER: And I would like to move 17 those into the record. 18 EXAMINER WALSTRA: They will be admitted. 19 (EXHIBITS ADMITTED INTO EVIDENCE.) 20 MS. MESSENGER: And that is all staff has 21 today. 2.2 EXAMINER WALSTRA: Okay. The Commission 23 will take your motion under advisement, and we will 24 issue a ruling in the future. Thank you. 25 We're adjourned.
