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Re: *In the Matter of the Application Seeking Approval of Ohio Power Company's Proposal to Enter into an Affiliate Power Purchase Agreement for Inclusion in the Power Purchase Agreement Rider, Case No. 14-1693-EL-RDR; In the Matter of the Application of Ohio Power Company for Approval of Certain Accounting Authority, Case No. 14-1694-EL-AAM*

Dear Attorney Examiners:

On May 15, 2014, Ohio Power Company (AEP Ohio) filed its Amended Application in this proceeding. On December 14, 2015, AEP Ohio, the Staff and other intervenors filed a Joint Stipulation and Recommendation to resolve the issues presented in the Amended Application and other matters (Stipulation). Pursuant to the Commission's March 31, 2016 Opinion and Order in this proceeding (Opinion and Order), the Company's Amended Application was approved and modified, consistent with the terms of the Stipulation and the modifications made in the Opinion and Order. On that basis, while the Company fully reserves its right to pursue rehearing, AEP Ohio and AEP Generation Resources, Inc. executed the Affiliate PPA on March 31, 2016 with an effective date of April 1, 2016. Because the OVEC PPA was already in effect, both PPAs underlying the PPA Rider are currently in effect and being implemented. In accordance with the directives in Opinion and Order (pages 107-108), AEP Ohio is submitting its compliance tariff relating to the Power Purchased Agreement (PPA) Rider effective today. Consistent with the Opinion and Order, the net effects will flow through the rider beginning on June 1, 2016.
