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Re: *In the Matter of the Application of Ohio Power Company for Authority to Establish a Standard Service Offer Pursuant to §4928.143, Revised Code, in the Form of an Electric Security Plan*, Case No. 13-2385-EL-SSO and Case No. 15-2051-EL-RDR

Attorney Examiners:

In its May 28, 2015 Entry in Case No. 13-2385-EL-SSO, the Commission approved the compliance tariffs filed by the Company on April 24, 2015, and supplemented on May 18, 2015. The compliance tariffs reflected a reduced Transmission Cost Recovery Rider (TCRR) rate designed to collect the TCRR under-recovery over 12 months. As of March 2016, the under-recovery balance is \$1,327,933. The Company anticipates this balance will be fully recovered at the end of the April billing month. Therefore, absent Commission action, the Company will terminate collection of the TCRR from customers effective with the first billing cycle of May, which is April 29. After termination of collection, the Company will include any remaining TCRR balance in its next Auction Cost Reconciliation Rider filing for final reconciliation with customers. The Company has worked with Staff to develop this approach.
