ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) On October 30, 2009, the Walter C. Beckjord Generating Station (Beckjord) filed an application for certification as an eligible Ohio renewable energy resource generating facility, as defined by R.C. 4928.01(A)(37). Beckjord submitted for certification a 1,125 Megawatt (MW) facility, comprised of six generating units, which were to be converted to co-fire biomass energy materials, including, but not limited to, raw wood chips, herbaceous crops, wood pellets, and agriculture waste, with coal. On September 9, 2010, Certificate No. 10-BIO-OH-GATS-0315 was issued with an effective date of September 8, 2010.
- (2) On January 22, 2016, Staff filed a Staff Report in this case recommending that the certificate be revoked as the generating facility has been deactivated. Staff notes that Beckjord filed generator deactivation requests with PJM for each of the six generating units and that each of the Beckjord units has been deactivated.¹
- (3) Accordingly, the Commission finds that Certificate No. 10-BIO-OH-GATS-0315 should be revoked and this case be dismissed and closed of record.
