ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) On June 29, 2010, the Muskingum River Plant (Muskingum) filed an application for certification as an eligible Ohio renewable energy resource generating facility, as defined by R.C. 4928.01(A)(37). Muskingum submitted for certification a 1,425 Megawatt (MW) facility, which was proposed to be converted to co-fire biomass fuel and biodiesel with coal and fuel oil. Thereafter, Certificate No. 10-BIO-OH-GATS-0463 was issued for Muskingum.
- (2) On January 22, 2016, Staff filed a Staff Report in this case recommending that the certificate be revoked as the generating facility has been deactivated. Staff notes that Picway filed a generator deactivation request with PJM and the unit has been deactivated.<sup>1</sup>
- (3) Accordingly, the Commission finds that that Certificate No. 10-BIO-OH-GATS-0463 should be revoked and this case be dismissed and closed of record.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That Certificate No. 10-BIO-OH-GATS-0463 be revoked and this case be dismissed and closed of record, in accordance with Finding (3). It is, further,


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
