## <u>ENTRY</u>

## The Commission finds:

- (1) Pursuant to R.C. 4927.21, the Commission has authority to consider written complaints filed against a telephone company by any person or corporation regarding any rate, service, regulation, or practice relating to any service furnished by the telephone company that is in any respect unjust, unreasonable, insufficient, or unjustly discriminatory.
- (2) First Communications LLC (First Communications) is a telephone company as defined in R.C. 4905.03 and, as such, is subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission.
- (3) On September 4, 2015, Sound Board Music, Inc. (Sound Board) filed a complaint against First Communications. Sound Board alleged that First Communications billed it for calls that Sound Board did not make.
- (4) On September 24, 2015, First Communications filed an answer in which it denied the material allegations of the complaint.
- (5) By Entry issued October 23, 2015, the attorney examiner scheduled a settlement conference to take place on November 24, 2015.
- (6) On March 10, 2016, the parties filed a joint motion to dismiss the complaint with prejudice. The parties explain that they

have reached a total settlement of the matters raised by the complaint.

(7) The Commission finds that the joint motion to dismiss the complaint is reasonable. Accordingly, the complaint should be dismissed with prejudice.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED. That the joint motion to dismiss the complaint be granted and that the complaint be dismissed with prejudice. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon all parties and interested persons of record.
