On page 36 of its August 8, 2012 Opinion and Order in these proceedings (ESP II Case), the Commission directed Ohio Power Company (AEP Ohio) to file its actual shopping statistics for the ESP II term in this docket. On page 13 of its April 2, 2015 Finding and Order in Case No. 14-1186-EL-RDR (Retail Stability Rider Case), the Commission reiterated this same directive.

The Commission's Finding and Order in the Retail Stability Rider Case also adopted AEP Ohio's proposal to conduct a financial audit of the capacity deferral balance (which was based on the same final shopping statistics being submitted here). The Commission indicated that a subsequent entry would establish the process for review of the auditor's findings and recommendations.

On July 21, 2015 the Company filed its final shopping statistics in this case. Since that time, there was an inadvertent error discovered in the load data provided from June 2014 through May 2015. The Company is attaching the updated shopping statistics to update not correct the record in the ESP III case. As referenced above, however, this correction does not impact the calculation of the RSR deferral balance. Since that filing had already used the correct shopping statistics.
