Duke Energy spokesperson Sally Thelen said the new pipeline will allow other infrastructure to be retired and the new pipeline will better serve customers. Neighbors question why the line can't be built along I-71. Thelen said there are right of way and width requirements Duke can't meet. "You'd think you could build it right along the road or the shoulder and that's not enough room for us either," Thelen said.

We spoke to industry experts with pipeline construction engineering experience and intimate knowledge of I-71 who are saying that this statement from Sally Thelen is FALSE. It may cost more to get it done, but it's definitely doable with current technology, techniques, and existing regulations. So it comes down to money and not truth. Plain and simple.
