I am writing to oppose Duke Energy's Central Corridor Pipeline Extension Project. All three potential routes should be rejected because they are destructive and dangerous. Each goes through densely populated areas surrounded by residences, schools, day care and community centers, businesses and houses of worship. The pipeline installation process would cause significant disruption and ultimately destruction of trees and landscaping, both in private and public areas, to the serious and permanent detriment of our communities. For example, in Amberley Village where I live, two of the potential routes would include the major artery of our community, Ridge Road. It is a winding, tree-lined two-lane road whose ambiance is key to the atmosphere of the village. Removing the trees for the pipeline here and elsewhere in Amberley along the proposed routes would negatively affect our property values for generations. I am opposed to this sort of destruction anywhere, not just in my own locale. Further, a pipeline of this size and magnitude would be dangerous for our communities. Nothing is perfectly safe, and the risk of a pipeline explosion in central Hamilton County is simply unacceptable by any measure.
