As a Blue Ash resident, and parent of a child entering Sycamore Schools as a Kindergartener at Blue Ash Elementary this fall, I feel it is my responsibility to voice my opposition to Duke Energy's proposed gas line routes of the Central Corridor Gas Line Extension Project, particularly the "Pink" and the "Blue" lines that would run in what appears to be close proximity to Blue Ash Elementary School.

I question whether installing a similar pipeline to the one that recently exploded in Pennsylvania (lasting 35 years after being installed in 1981, and inspected and cleared in 2012), in a residential area close to our schools, is truly a long term, safe solution to the gas distribution issue. I understand that after 197 possible routes for this gas pipeline were eliminated by Duke Energy, that 2 out of the 3 remaining possible routes run past both an elementary school and a university, as well as through wooded residential lots in our community. I would not be doing my due diligence as a responsible citizen if I did not urge Duke Energy and the OPSB to re-visit one of those 197 eliminated options, which may cost more, but ultimately put less people at potential risk, especially students in our community.
