On April 5, 2016, a complaint was filed in Case No. 16-718-GA-CSS against Constellation Gas Co. Constellation requests that the Commission dismiss this Complaint by June 29 if it does not receive any contrary statement from the Complainant by June 22, 2016. WHEREFORE, the Respondent requests that this Complaint and any settlement conference

subsequently scheduled be dismissed and cancelled on the grounds that the Complaint has been settled.
