Subject: Duke Natural Gas Transmission Proposals

Gentlemen: Duke Energy has submitted three alternative proposals [above] for a 30 inch transmission natural gas pipeline all of which go through residential/highly populated areas near Cincinnati, OH. These transmission lines operate at very high pressures [700+psi], and in other locations they have ruptured causing serious damage for 2000 feet on both sides [a total of .4 miles]. Hence they pose a serious risk to residents within this .4 mile corridor.

Duke Energy, in a letter to residents, has falsely stated that this 30 inch transmission pipeline would service the greater Cincinnati area. This statement is not true. Its true destination is far south of our area.

Based on these facts, we sincerely urge you to strenuously oppose any approval of these three proposals by Duke Energy as well as any future plan to route such a transmission line through heavily populated areas.

We would also request that you initiate/support Ohio legislation that would ban all future requests of this nature.
