To whom it may concern

I received notice that Duke Energy wants to route a 30" gas main through the eastern side of Hamilton County. They have 3 suggested routes.

One is south bound under Blue Ash Road. That route shall be eliminated. Blue Ash road was just repaved last year from the Blue Ash City line to Deer Park. Duke Energy and any of their contractors do not repave streets properly and the patching they provide will break up in 2 years and we the taxpayers will have to pay to repave Blue Ash road again.

Furthermore, any route Duke Energy selects, they must repave the street from curb to curb.

Also all three routes have too many turns in them which reduces flow and the possible increase in pressure.
