All of the proposed routes will create massive risks to the environment, risks to our health and safety, risks to our air and water quality.

High speed, high capacity natural gas pipelines Do NOT belong in densely populated residential areas, near our homes, schools, where we work or worship.

If there were an accident involving one of these lines, it would be a huge catastrophic event with potential for widespread injuries, death and destruction of property.

Accidents both large and small do happen on a regular basis

Duke has not demonstrated a commitment to safety or industry best practices and therefor should not be allowed to undertake this project.

Pipelines of this size must be routed to rural areas safely away from all residential communities.

I live in the community of Pleasant Ridge, Ohio and this pipeline would directly affect the quality of my life, my family, my home, my neighbors and my community. I do not wish to live in fear of a gas leak or gasoline explosion. I do not wish to see parks uprooted and natural animal habitats destroyed from the building of this pipeline.
