- {¶ 1} On November 12, 2015, Willian M. Heyman (Complainant) filed a complaint against Frontier Communications, Inc. (Frontier). The complaint alleges that Frontier failed to mark its telephone lines properly and that the lines were damaged as a result of the Complainant excavating near his rental property. The Complainant sought information and demanded that Frontier fill in the excavation site.
- $\{\P\ 2\}$ After being granted leave, Frontier filed an answer and a motion to dismiss on December 28, 2015.
- {¶ 3} On January 15, 2016, the attorney examiner scheduled a settlement conference for February 23, 2016.
- $\{\P 4\}$ On February 16, 2016, the Complainant moved for a continuance of the settlement conference in order to conduct discovery.
- {¶ 5} By Entry issued February 23, 2016, the attorney examiner granted the Complainant's request for a continuance. The attorney examiner scheduled a settlement conference for April 28, 2016.

On January 14, 2016, Frontier refiled its answer which included a page missing from its December 28, 2015 filing.

{¶ 6} The settlement conference took place, as scheduled, on April 28, 2016.

- {¶ 7} In his complaint, the Complainant listed five requests:
 - (a) that Frontier fill in the excavation site,
 - (b) that Frontier provide the Ohio Utilities Protection Services (OUPS) ticket number and the issue date for Frontier's newly installed telephone line,
 - (c) that Frontier disclose the date it installed the new line,
 - (d) that a copy of case number WHEY09231500 and copies of any future correspondence or investigation be provided to the Complainant,
 - (e) and that the Complainant be informed as to the depth of Frontier's new telephone line.
- $\{\P 8\}$ Before deciding whether this matter should proceed to hearing, the Complainant shall provide by June 30, 2016, a written statement that identifies which of these requests or issues remain to be decided by the Commission.
 - $\{\P 9\}$ It is, therefore,
- {¶ 10} ORDERED, That the Complainant file by June 30, 2016, a statement that identifies the requests or issues that he wishes the Commission to address. It is, further,
