MEMORANDUM IN SUPPORT

The Commission issued Certificate No. 14-834E(1), which certified the Village of Carrollton as a competitive retail electric service provider to provide governmental aggregation services effective June 30, 2014. By its terms, the certificate is set to expire on June 30, 2016.

In order to continue the effectiveness of the Village of Carrollton's certificate and to provide Staff adequate time to review the renewal application, the Village of Carrollton respectfully requests an extension of its Competitive Retail Electric Service Provider Certificate from the date of the filing of its June 21, 2016, renewal application, up through and including at least July 22, 2016 (or such longer time as the Commission deems necessary to perform its review and avoid any break in the certificate).¹ The extension will not prejudice any party.

For the foregoing reasons, the motion should be granted.
