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

- 1) DUKE ENGINEER WAS UNSURE IF COMPLIANCE WITH TITLE 49 (CFR) PART 192 WAS MANDATORY OR A "GUIDELINE" - NEED CLARIFICATION
- 2) CONCERN THAT DUKE MAY GO WITH LOW BID FOR INSTALLATION CONTRACTOR LEADING TO QUALITY ISSUES - NEED ASSURANCES CONTRACTOR NOT YET SELECTED
