Commissioners:

I have spent these past few weeks reading and trying to understand the Central Corridor Pipeline proposals through Cincinnati (Hamilton County).

The short-term effects would be a construction site along busy corridors (Glendale-Milford Road would affect my household and community). The long term effects would be safety, environmental and property values.

The proposal affecting my household and community would be the one traveling along Glendale-Milford Road in Evendale. My residence is a short distance from this proposed high pressure, high-volume transmission gas pipeline. We are very concerned for our safety and the safety of other residents and children who attend Evendale Elementary School and those attending the churches fronting Glendale-Milford Road.

We would like to go on record as opposing this large, high pressure gas line as proposed with all the current routes through densely populated communities.

It is our request that as the Board, PUCO, and Duke Energy decide what best routes will be taken, you thoughtfully and carefully consider the potential impact this project will have on our property values (residential and commercial), our property insurance rates, quality of life in the affected residential areas, and on our government's ability to be fiscally responsible.

Please reevaluate the Central Corridor Gas Pipeline Extension Project and find better alternatives than through our densely populated and settled communities in Hamilton County. Perhaps an alternative route outside the I-275 beltway would be a better option to reduce the risk to these residential communities.

Please deny this application and protect the citizens of Ohio.
