This is to certify that the images appearing ere as accurate and complete reproduction of a crew filt document desivered in the regular course of 0.000000000 Technician Accord Date Processed 6.43/16 I am writing to you on behalf of the Amberley Village Police/Fire Department to express our concerns over the proposed Central Corridor Gas Pipeline.

In reviewing the proposed "pink" route (<u>https://www.duke-energy.com/pdfs/ProposedRoute-rev.pdf</u>), the pipeline would extend through Amberley Village the length of Ridge Road. As you and I both know, Ridge Road serves as the main thoroughfare of the Village, connecting the North and South ends in the most expeditious way possible.

With this is mind, I express to you grave concerns over the potentially life threatening consequences heavy construction along Ridge Road may have related to police department business. With our main artery blocked, first responders (police, fire, EMS) would experience heavy delays during emergency responses; whether they're stuck in construction traffic or having to reroute around traffic and access their end destination via a much longer, slower route.

I hope you will take our safety concerns as the Village moves forward in their communications with Duke Energy and the Ohio Power Siting Board.
