To whom it may concern:

I cannot stress strongly enough my opposition to the the Central Corridor Pipeline Extension Project. Allowing the expansion through these densely populated areas poses a completely avoidable safety risk to these neighborhoods, especially the over 30 local public and private schools and 23 daycare centers within the dangerous "burn zone" along the proposed routes.

If images of children burning inside their school is not enough for you to throw your entire weight into killing this proposal, maybe imagining your response to "why didn't you stop this?" at a press conference will be.

I implore you, person of power, end this. Do not allow this pipeline expansion through these neighborhoods.
